

CIR ROSARY PRAYER GROUP

Welcome to our Catholic in Recovery rosary group. This is a prayer group held Saturday at 11:30pm ET / 8:30am PT that gathers online and over the phone

1. We begin by making the **Sign of the Cross**. Hold the Crucifix, and say the **Apostles' Creed**. On the first bead, say an **Our Father**. Say one **Hail Mary** on each of the next three beads. Say the **Glory Be**.
2. For each of the five decades, announce the Mystery then say the **Our Father**. While fingering each of the ten beads of the decade, next say ten **Hail Marys** while meditating on the Mystery. Then say a **Glory Be**.
3. After finishing each decade, say the **Fatima Prayer**: O my Jesus, forgive us our sins, save us from the fires of hell, lead all souls to Heaven, especially those in most need of Thy mercy.
4. After the five decades, say the **Hail, Holy Queen**, followed by, **✠** Pray for us, O holy Mother of God, **✠** That we may be made worthy of the promises of Christ. Let us pray: O God, whose Only Begotten Son, by his life, Death, and Resurrection, has purchased for us the rewards of eternal life, grant, we beseech thee, that while meditating on these mysteries of the most holy Rosary of the Blessed Virgin Mary, we may imitate what they contain and obtain what they promise, through the same Christ our Lord. Amen.

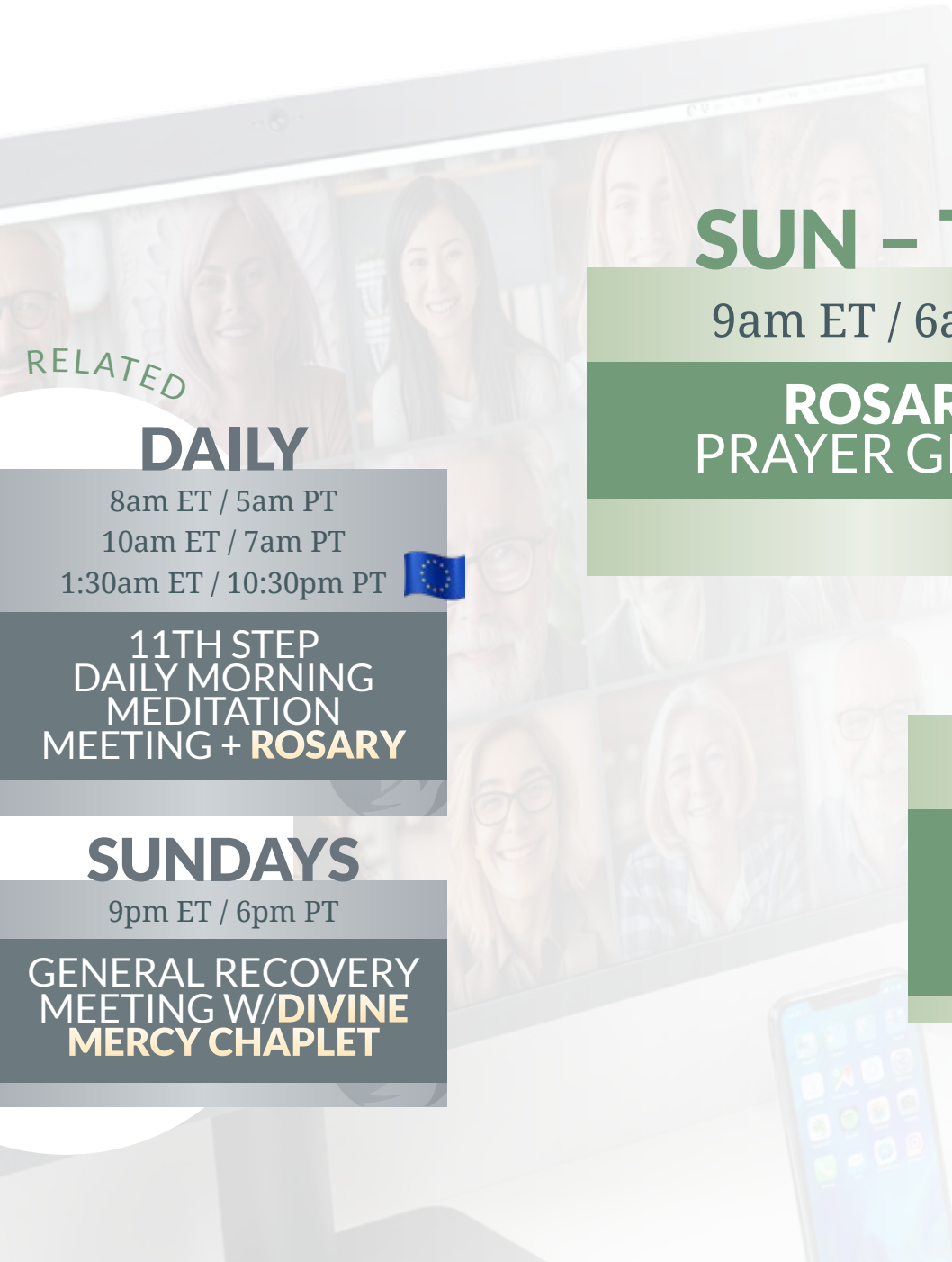
THE JOYFUL MYSTERIES are traditionally prayed on Mondays, Saturdays, and, during the season of Advent, on Sundays — The Annunciation, The Visitation The Nativity, The Presentation in the Temple, and The Finding in the Temple.

THE SORROWFUL MYSTERIES are traditionally prayed on Tuesdays, Fridays, and, during the season of Lent, on Sundays — The Agony in the Garden, The Scourging at the Pillar, The Crowning with Thorns, The Carrying of the Cross, and The Crucifixion and Death.

THE GLORIOUS MYSTERIES are traditionally prayed on Wednesdays and, outside the seasons of Advent and Lent, on Sundays — The Resurrection, The Ascension, The Descent of the Holy Spirit, The Assumption, and The Coronation of Mary.

THE LUMINOUS MYSTERIES are traditionally prayed on Thursdays — The Baptism of Christ in the Jordan, The Wedding Feast at Cana, Jesus' Proclamation of the Coming of the Kingdom of God, The Transfiguration, and The Institution of the Eucharist.
